



Town Project Update for week of July 10th, 2018

The following new work has **begun this week**:

- Main Street Sidewalks:
 - Excavation of the south side of Main St started July 9, 2018 and pouring should start by Friday.
 - The north side boulevard will be finished this week
 - New trees will be planted along these boulevards this fall
- Road Repair Program with Diamond Construction
 - Patching will begin this week and reconstruction of 3rd St S will start shortly after. There will be limited driveway/road closures as this rehab work is done. Contractor will be notifying residents if access to property is limited.
- Paving of the patching locations could begin as early as Thursday, July 12th.
 - Renewal work on Cedar Drive will follow as well as paving of 6th Avenue South intersection
- Removal of the old baseball dug-outs has begun, and work on the new enclosed dugout will begin thereafter.
- Compost material will be moved starting July 10th, this will be mixed with topsoil and peat-moss and be used for parks and landscaping projects.
- Weed letters were sent out to non-compliant lots, any concerns please contact the office.
- Now that the road lines are painted, painting of curbs (no-parking zones) will begin this week.
- Due to the dry weather we are experiencing the wetlands is in need of extra water, water from the ponds in Fifth Avenue Estates will be pumped to the wetlands. Crown Valley Road will be closed for a period of time to accomplish this task. We will post the dates on social media as soon as it is available.
- Operation staff continue to larvicide throughout Town.
- See any graffiti or damage on Town property? Let us know!
