Minutes of the special meeting of the Niverville Town Council held on August 4, 2016 at 12:05 p.m. at the Niverville Civic Office. Deputy Mayor John Funk chaired the meeting with Councillors Kevin Stott and Chris Wiebe in attendance. All members of Council had been advised of the meeting and the agenda.

Res#220-16 J. Funk – C. Wiebe

PR 311 WHEREAS the Town of Niverville has in partnership with Manitoba
PR 622 Infrastructure, managed the development of supporting infrastructure along PR
311 (Main Street) between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue;
AND WHEREAS the Town currently has responsibility for the care and control
of Main Street between Heritage Trail and the west side of 5th Avenue, a working
agreement between the Province of Manitoba and the Town of Niverville that has
historically worked well in protecting and promoting the interest of both parties;
AND WHEREAS moving forward with the development of water infrastructure
and sidewalk placement Council considers it in the best interest of the community
for the Town to assume responsibility for the care and control of PR 311 (Main
Street) from 5th Avenue to 6th Avenue;
AND WHEREAS Council would be prepared to consider a similar arrangement
for PR 622 (5th Avenue South) from Main Street to Crown Valley Road as 5th
Avenue South is a developed arterial road within the community;
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED Council respectfully requests that Manitoba
Infrastructure consider abandoning a portion of PR 311 (Main Street) from the
west side of 5th Avenue to the east side of 6th Avenue in the Town of Niverville
and have it changed to a “designated” road, with the Town of Niverville being
responsible for the care and control in accordance with currently agreed upon
standards and Manitoba Infrastructure continuing to be responsible for the
maintenance thereof.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Council convey to Manitoba
Infrastructure its willingness to assume responsibility for the care and control of
PR 622 (5th Avenue South) from Main Street to Crown Valley road should it be in
the best interest of Manitoba Infrastructure.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Council respectfully requests that
Manitoba Infrastructure consider the redefining of PR 311 (Main Street) as
described above to take effect either immediately or within a reasonable time as
will be mutually agreed to.
