## TOWN OF NIVERVILLE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL PESTICIDE PROGRAM

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2016:

1. To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public reserves and parks with in the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M to control noxious weeds. The program will run from May 2, 2016 to October 14, 2016 using a ground sprayer.
2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitoes, the Town may larvacide using Aquabac 200g. This program will commence from May 2, 2016 to October 31, 2016.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of those of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.

## TOWN CLEAN-UP DAYS – APRIL 30 & MAY 1

**\*\*NEW FORMAT FOR 2016\*\***

Planning Ahead? If you are ready to tackle your spring cleaning then you will want to mark your calendar for the Town’s Clean-up Days scheduled for April 30th and May 1st.

Here’s what’s new for 2016. Residents will have opportunity to dispose of larger items normally not picked up during regular weekly waste collection by bringing them to the Centennial Arena. During April 30th and May 1st only, between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., staff will be on site to direct the placement of waste in large bins. These bins will be removed each evening.

**Please note that the following items cannot be disposed of in the bins:**

- Liquids and Hazardous materials.
- Appliances with ozone depleting substances (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners)

WM Dyck & Sons (262 Main St.) will accept old paint, stain, varnish or water sealant ***provided*** these products are dropped off at their paint counter in their original container complete with a lid and label.

Residents may dispose of the following items at the Bristol Hauling yard site, 41135 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue North:

- No charge: Oil, Propane Tanks, Batteries, Metal
- For a Fee
- Tires - \$15/tire
- Branches - pick-up truck or single axle trailer \$10.00/load
  - Anything over these load sizes will be \$70/ton as they will be considered commercial

*Grass clippings/leaves* can continue to be dropped off at the Town’s compost site located north of the curling rink on Arena Road. Please smile as you will likely be on camera.
