2016 Road Restrictions

NEW REGULATIONS FOR COMPOST SITE

Effective March 1, 2016, the Town's compost site located behind the Curling Rink is limited to accepting grass clippings and leaves. It will NO longer be accepting any tree branches, wood products or other rubble. The new regulation is as a result of the compost site continuously receiving products that cannot be chipped and composted.

Licensing of Pets



All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed. Annual license fee is currently \$20.00 per pet, valid for 12 months from date of issue. *Please note that dogs and cats are not permitted to run at large.* In the event that an impounded dog or cat is found to be unlicensed at the time of capture, the license fee is \$100.00. The fee for first time impoundment is \$150.00, \$60.00 capture fee, plus \$10.00 per each day within the pound (applicable fees subject to GST). Proof of rabies and distemper vaccination must be presented at the time of application before a license can be issued. Note that the breed of the dog must be documented on the vaccination papers presented for licensing. Licenses can be obtained from the Town office (86 Main Street) during regular office hours.
