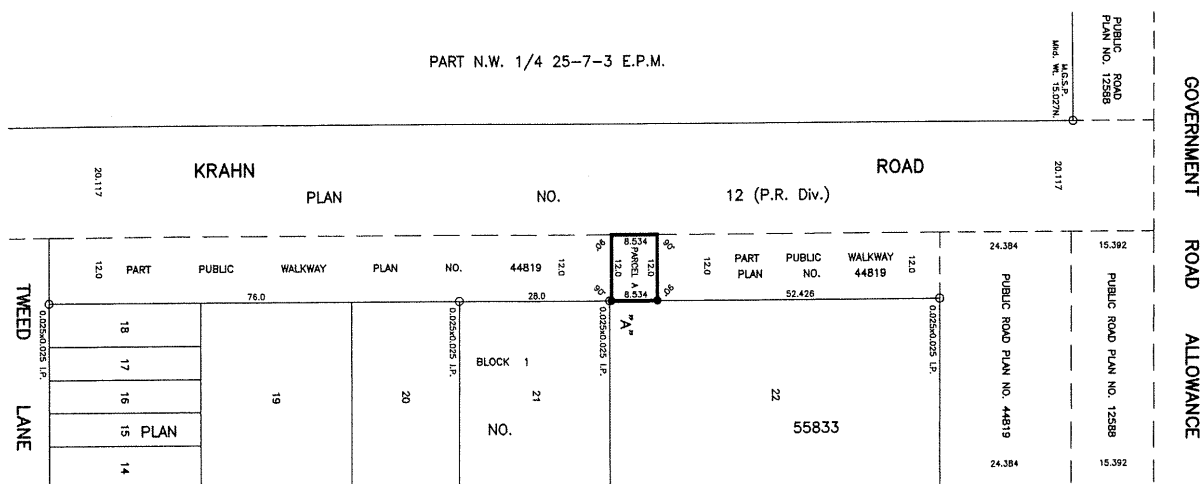

A copy of the above proposal and supporting material may be inspected at the Niverville Civic Office, 86 Main Street, Niverville during normal office hours, Monday to Friday. Copies may be made and extracts taken therefrom, upon request.

The Town of Niverville will be doing its annual sewer cleaning during the week beginning August 22, 2016. The locations that will be cleaned are Fifth Avenue Estates and Vista Cove. There is no exact route or exact timeline when they will be in these areas.

Occasionally during cleaning and inspection, air pressure in the sewer can cause water to splash out of your toilets, sinks, and drains. Please take the following precautions to prevent water damage in your home:

- * Close lids and cover toilet bowls when not in use
- * Insert drain plugs in all sinks and bathtubs when not in use
- * Remove all floor mats in bathrooms
- * Place an old towel around base of toilets
- * Cover all basement floor drains.



Sometimes the sewer cleaning and inspection leaves an odor in the home. If so, run some water down all sinks and bathtub drains, flush toilets, pour a pail of water into each basement floor drain and open your windows. After a short time the odor should disappear. VOTING LOCATION

Location for voting will be open on **Wednesday, September 14, 2016** between **8:00 a.m.** and **8:00 p.m.** at the **South End Meeting Room, Niverville Centennial Arena, Arena Road.**

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE.

A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example—driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they may be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the **Niverville Curling Rink, Arena Road** and will be open on **Wednesday, September 7, 2016 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.**

MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside either in a personal care home or senior facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following locations on **September 9, 2016.**

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| 1. Niverville Heritage Personal Care Home | 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. |
| 2. Niverville Credit Union Manor | 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. |

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person or in writing to the Senior Election Official at Niverville Civic Offices, 86 Main Street, Box 267, Niverville Manitoba, R0A 1E0 or by fax at (204) 388-6110.

If applying in person, a voter may apply between August 17, 2016 and September 9, 2016. A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by mail or fax, a voter may apply between August 11, 2016 and September 9, 2016. A voter applying by mail or fax will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the Senior Election Official.
