Pet Licensing



Effective November 15, 2016, the pet license renewal fee will be reduced to \$15.00 for renewals that are done on or before the due date. Please note that the fee for a new pet license will remain at \$20 per pet and past due license renewal fee will remain at \$20. Up to date rabies and distemper information must be presented at the time of licensing and renewals.

All replacement tags, either lost or destroyed will be \$10 plus GST.

In the event that your pet is picked up by Animal Control, you will be charged a fee of \$200 for first time impoundment. In addition, should your pet be unlicensed or have a past due license at the time of impoundment, a license fee of \$100 will apply.
