The Open House will be overseen by CH2M, traffic engineering consultants hired by the Town. Please plan to attend as this will be your opportunity to review the design criteria for infrastructure planning as well as share your suggestions for traffic management.

Additions to the Voters List and/or Personal Security Protection Requests

In accordance with Section 36 of *The Municipal Councils and School Board Elections Act (MCSBEA)*, the Town of Niverville Voters List is open for changes or revisions.

- Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the Local Authority of the Town of Niverville can have his or her name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the voter in the Voters List corrected.
- Any person can request to have his or her name and address obscured from the Voters List.

A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. In a civic election, that person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.
