

TOWN OF NIVERVILLE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL PESTICIDE PROGRAM

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2018:

- 1. To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public reserves and parks with in the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M. The program will run from May 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018 using a ground sprayer.
- 2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitoes, the Town may larvacide using Aquabac 200g.
 This program will commence from May 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of those of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.
