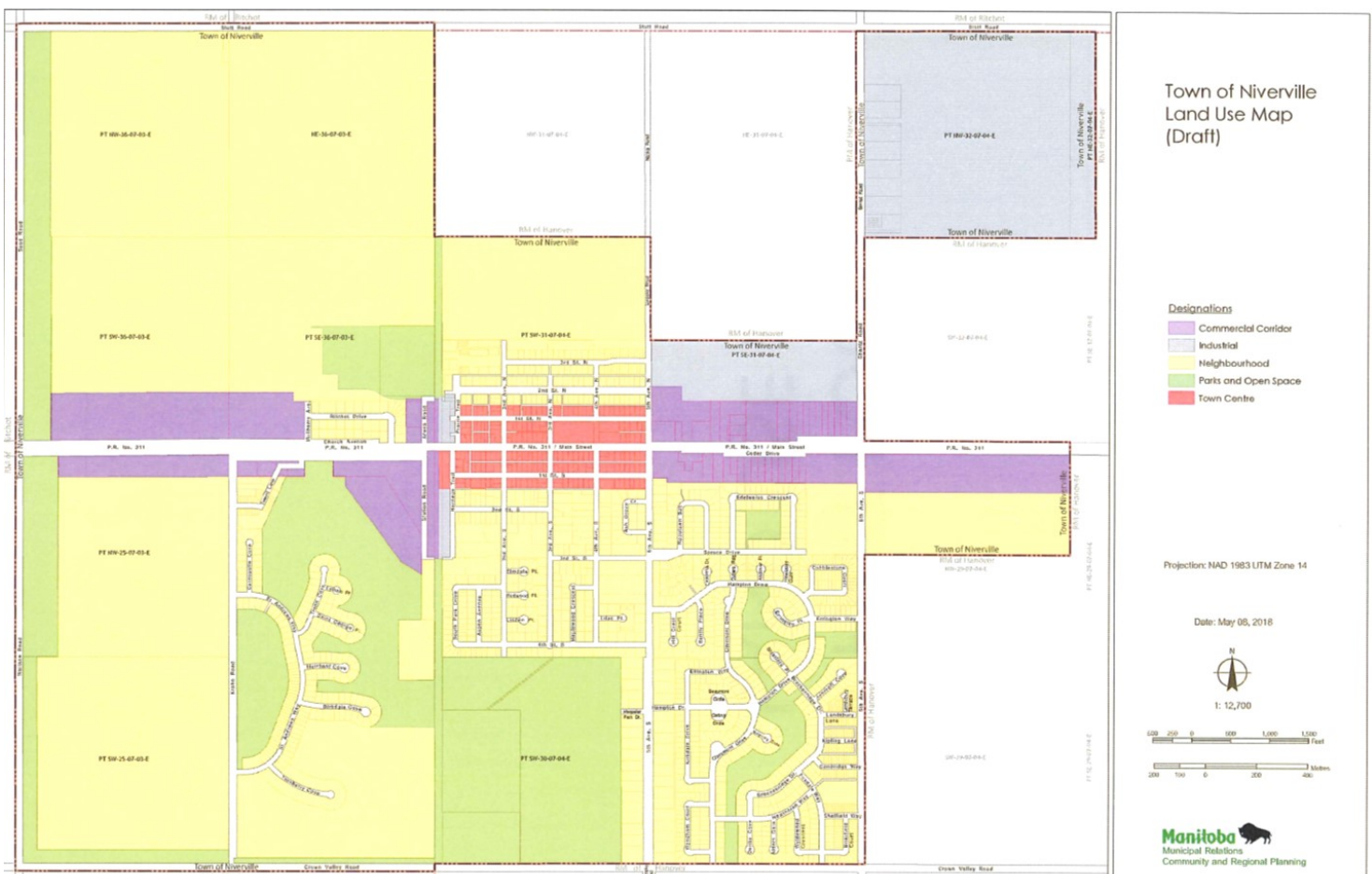

Licensing of Pets



All dogs and cats over the age of six months must be licensed. Annual license fee is currently \$20.00 per pet, valid for 12 months from date of issue. **Please note that dogs and cats are not permitted to run at large.** In the event that an impounded dog or cat is found to be unlicensed at the time of capture, the license fee is \$100.00. The fee for first time impoundment is \$200. Proof of rabies and distemper vaccination must be presented at the time of application before a license can be issued. Note that the breed of the dog must be documented on the vaccination papers presented for licensing. Licenses may be obtained from the Town Office (86 Main Street) during regular office hours.
