

RM Private Well Water Testing Days 2019

The **SEINE-RAT RIVER CONSERVATION DISTRICT** will be assisting residents with private well water testing for the presence of *E. coli* and coliform bacteria. The cost of private well water testing is **\$22.31**, including tax. Each legal location is eligible for one sample per well at the subsidized rate. Payment may be submitted by cash or cheque **ONLY**, with cheques made payable to **Horizon Lab Ltd**. Horizon Lab is also offering a new expedited service. Customers can pay an extra \$10 to have their bacteria water test report sent by the following business day.

Water sample bottles & application forms can be picked up in advance at your participating RM office. Water samples must be taken on the same day as the drop-off. Drop your water sample off at your participating RM office **prior to 10:00 am**, along with your completed Chain of Custody and SRRCD Application forms.

Niverville Spring Clean Up Days New Collection Location for 2019!

If you are ready to tackle your Spring Cleaning, mark your calendar for the Town's Spring Clean Up days scheduled for May $10^{\rm th}$ and $11^{\rm th}$.

Niverville residents will have the opportunity to dispose of larger items normally not picked up during regular weekly waste collection by bringing them to the **Bristal Hauling** yard located at **405 Kuzenko Street** (Niverville Business Park located approx. 3/4 mile north on 6th Avenue). The following items may be disposed of:

- Garbage
- Recycling
- Yard waste including branches
- Scrap metal
- Wood
- Concrete
- E-waste
- Tires
- Propane tanks
- Paint
- CFL's and fluorescent light bulbs
- Used oil & oil filters
- Appliances \$20/per fridge or freezer, all other appliances no charge

Note: **Items need to be separated for drop off into appropriate area**. Bristal Hauling will be monitoring all movement and use while residents are on or near their property.

The hours that items may be dropped off are as follows:

Friday, May 10, 2019 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, May 11, 2019 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
