This document will help you understand what it required on a site plan when applying for a permit for a single unit or duplex home.

What information should be included on the site plan?

The site plan should have the following information:

- 1. street names, lot dimensions, civic address, legal description and north arrow;
- 2. dimensions from building to property lines (building to building if applicable);
- 3. on irregular shaped lots, dimensions from the property lines to the closest projections within side yards must be included;
- 4. dimensions of all projections such as cantilevers, a/c units, decks, chimneys and steps;
- 5. width of the driveway at the approach;
- 6. location and dimensions of registered easements;
- 7. ALL MEASUREMENTS MUST BE CLEAR AND LEDGABLE.

NOTE: The site plan and drawings must match.
