

WHEREAS By-law 854-23 Mobile Food Service Units defines the approved location requirements for mobile food service units to operate within the Town limits;
AND WHEREAS Adrian Bruce, owner/operator of Tortuga’s Smokehouse would like to set up his food truck at 259 Main Street on September 15, 2024, to serve the public in conjunction with a Nighthawks event;
AND WHEREAS 259 Main Street is private property that does not conform with the 200-meter setback for businesses in the adjacent area selling consumable goods;
AND WHEREAS By-law 854-23 allows for exemptions to the By-law to be made by resolution of Council;
AND WHEREAS the owner of 259 Main Street has provided approval for the food truck to set up on their property for the event and letters of support have been received from the owner of Niverville Subway and the Niverville Chamber of Commerce;
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council approves an exemption to the 200 meter setback to allow the Tortuga’s Smokehouse food truck to set up at 259 Main Street on September 15, 2024, subject to the vendor taking out a Mobile Food Service Unit Licence from the Town.


