



BOIL WATER ADVISORY

For 101-103 St. Andrews Way

Starting: September 16th, 2026

Due to the temporary planned loss of pressure in the local water main to facilitate new municipal water connections, the safety of the drinking water cannot be guaranteed for the areas listed above.

All water from taps should be boiled (rolling boil) for at least 1 minute if it is to be used for human consumption

Boiling water removes harmful bacteria in the water that may cause illness. Once boiled, the water can be stored in the refrigerator in a clean food-safe container and should be used for other activities where it may be ingested, including:

1. Brushing teeth
2. Washing fruits and vegetables
3. Adding to uncooked food or drink
4. Ice cubes

The advisory shall remain in effect until a notice of rescind is issued
