Notice of Additions to the Voters List and/or Personal Security Protection Requests

In accordance with **Sections 33 & 36 of The Municipal Councils and School Board Elections Act**, the Town of Niverville Voters List is open for changes or revisions until the nomination period closes on **Tuesday, September 22nd, 2026**.

- Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the Local Authority of the Town of Niverville can have their name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the voter in the Voters List corrected.
- Any person can request to have his or her name and address obscured from the Voters List.
- A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. That person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.

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To be eligible to vote in a municipal election in the Town of Niverville, a person must be:

- A Canadian citizen;
- At least 18 years of age on election day; and
- A resident or registered owner of land in the Town of Niverville for at least six months on Election Day.

To implement the above, a written request including name and address along with proof of identity must be submitted to the Senior Election Official during regular Election Office hours. You can find the SEO's contact information below.

Notice of Nomination Period of Prospective Candidates for General Municipal Election

Please be advised that during regular Election Office Hours, between the dates of Sept. 16th and Sept. 22nd, 2026, at the Niverville Administration Office, 329 Bronstone Drive, Niverville, MB, the Senior Election Official will be receiving nominations for the offices of Councillor and Head of Council.

The nomination deadline is Tues., Sept. 22nd, 2026, at 5:00 PM. Nominations cannot be accepted after this day.

All nominations shall be made in writing and shall be signed by at least twenty-five voters, or NOT less than 1% of the voters (whichever is the lesser) of the authority or ward (as the case may be), but in all cases by at least two voters. Each nomination shall also be accompanied by the candidate's declaration of qualification.

Nominations may be filed in person at the above location, on the date and hours specified, by an agent, or by email. To obtain a nomination paper, and / or candidate's declaration of qualification, contact the SEO using the information listed below.

Nomination papers not accompanied by the required documents and not properly filed shall be rejected.
